Dear Partners in Mission,



I pray this finds you healthy and happy in your journey of life. Yet another year seems to be flying by. The second term of classes is well underway as I write this. I've picked up another class given a need as one professor left the department. It's giving me a chance to return to a class I taught once a few years ago. It's a larger class than I've had in a while, with some very animated and others going through the motions. Here a group is figuring out how gravity affects movements in different positions, a key concept for prescribing exercises for patients. Please pray for the students just going through the motions, that God may inspire them to give more of

themselves to their learning and patients.

Most of the houses we've worked on have been on a road, but we are currently working with a family who live on a foot alley, off of another foot alley. This requires the materials for the construction to be moved from where the truck can leave them, to the construction site. The family was unable to raise much cash to help with the labor costs, but have moved all of the materials to the work site, one wheelbarrow full at a time. About 10 cement blocks fit in the wheelbarrow and the house required almost 700 blocks, just to give you an idea of some of what is involved. Having the family pitching in where they can to see their dream realized has made this project satisfying. Please pray for all of the families seeking assistance, that those God enables us to help, truly partner together with us in the work as Wilson and his family have done.



An additional project in need of prayers is a PT conference that is being planned for early September. The enthusiasm demonstrated early on has waned a bit as the reality of the work load combined with the needs for organizing such an event became clearer. Please pray that God brings those together needed to accomplish the preparations in order to offer a professional continuing educational experience.
