FONHARE is the Foundation Haitienne de Rehabilitation and is located in Ounaminthe, Haiti. My friend, Ivens Louis, is the founder of this NGO, designed to provide rehabilitation services to the Haitian people who have limited resources and to educate the population about disabilities. I visited in May 2012 and hope to return for additional visits to support the development of this program.

Ouanaminthe, Haiti is the border city with Dajabon the Dominican counterpart. Market days are Mondays and Fridays, making the bridge over the Massacre River swamped with people carrying their purchases, often on their heads.

Use of a hand cart is often seen, loaded down with several hundred pounds of goods, pulled by one man in front and pushed by 2-3 men behind.





One method of crossing the border from the Dominican Republic to Haiti at Dajabon/Ounamint he. This avoids the official border controls and is a convenient way to cross after hours.
